



PMGA 2017 TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

and

AGA Team Championship Qualifier

Saturday April 1 and Sunday April 2

(Sign-up and pay at papagomensgolf.com, through Monday, March 27 @ 11pm)

ENTRY FEE: \$80.00 PER TEAM w/SELECTED PARTNER
\$40.00 PER PLAYER AS A SINGLE (PMGA will try to pair you)
(Teams must play both days)

FORMAT: Two-Man, Two-Day **TEAM BETTER BALL**, Gross and Net

- **Tees:** Saturday – Blue Tees; Sunday – PMGA Blue/White combo tees
- There will be Gross and Net winning teams
- **No handicap limit** between players on the same team

First Place Gross and Net Teams Qualify for the AGA Team Championship

- Teams **MUST** be available for a playoff in the event of a tie
- PMGA will pay the AGA Team Championship entry fees for the First Place Teams

This is a Premier PMGA Event – no Guests for this tournament

Optional Cash Games (all amounts are PER TEAM; these are Team better ball games*):

- Gross/Net Team Skins -- \$20, covers both days (skins awarded separately each day)
- Saturday games:
 - Gross and Net Par 3s -- \$10 for each (winner-take-all; bogey disqualifies)
 - Gross and Net Final Four (15-18) -- \$10 for each
- Sunday games:
 - Gross and Net Par 5s -- \$10 for each
 - Gross and Net “Amen Corner” (10 - 12) (in the Masters spirit!) -- \$10 for each
- Both partners must sign up for the same cash games to be eligible -- they are Team games
- * “Team better ball games” means the lower of the two scores counts for each applicable hole

RULES: Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and the PMGA Local Rules, and subject to PMGA Tournament Policies and Procedures and other rules and guidelines for PMGA events.

TIME CLOCK/PENALTIES: The 14-minute/2:10 rule is in effect.

- Each group must finish each nine holes within 14 minutes of the group ahead, or within 2:10 or less.
- **Time-clock:** One Marker must time stamp a scorecard **after** all Players have teed off on the first hole, and again **after** all Players have completed (putted out on) each nine (three stamped times total).
- Penalty: one stroke to each Team for each nine on which a violation occurs.
- Any appeal for a delay due to a lost ball on holes 8, 9, 17, or 18 must be made to the Committee promptly upon completion of the round.

SCORING: The Marker shall legibly record the gross scores of both Players on the other Team on each hole, as well as the Gross Better Ball and Net Better Ball score on the indicated row on the card, and add each Player’s scores for each nine and the Team’s Gross and Net Better Ball scores for each nine; the Players shall then check their card for legibility and accuracy as to each hole and each nine (individual scores and Gross and Net Better Ball scores; and the Marker and both Players shall then sign the card. The Players shall then hand their card to a Committee member and wait until the card has been checked and approved.
