



PMGA INVITATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

TWO-DAY ENTRY FEE: \$80.00 PER TEAM w/ SELECTED PARTNER
SINGLE DAY (SAT OR SUN): \$40.00 PER TEAM w/ SELECTED PARTNER

YOU MAY ENTER AS A SINGLE FOR ONE OR TWO-DAY EVENT (PMGA will pair you).

Individuals and guest teams are welcome. Checkout the great membership deal beginning July 1st.

FORMATS: *Script payout will be gross and net for daily team score and two-day total team score.*

Saturday front nine -- Scramble.

- Each player tees off on each hole. The team selects one first shot to be used, and both players hit from that spot. The players then select the second shot to be used and both players hit from that spot. The process is repeated until the ball is holed.
- On any area except the green, players may place the ball within 1 scorecard length from the spot where the ball is at rest. On the green, players may play the ball within 1 "putterhead" from the spot where the ball is at rest.
- Players may **not** move the ball from one playing surface to a different playing surface; for example, from the rough to the fairway, or from a hazard to a non-hazard. Specific playing surfaces include, but are not limited to, fairway, rough, bunker, desert, and inside a hazard.

Saturday back nine -- Modified Chapman Scotch.

- Both players tee off. Then, for the second shots, Player A plays Player B's drive, and vice-versa.
- After both players have hit their second shots, they then select the ball to be played. If Player A's second shot is selected, Player B hits the third shot, and vice versa. **Starting with the third shot, the team plays only one ball, in an alternate shot format, until the ball is holed.**

Sunday front nine -- Best Ball. Each player plays his own ball on the hole, and the lowest score is counted.

Sunday back nine -- Aggregate. Each player plays his own ball on the hole, and the scores are added.

OPTIONAL CASH GAMES WILL BE GROSS & NET TEAM SCORES FOR EACH 9-HOLE FORMAT. TEAMS CAN ONLY WIN ONE WAY.

SCORING: The **marker** shall record the team scores **in all formats** and sign the scorecard. **Both players from each team** are responsible to check and sign the scorecard before turning it into the committee.

RULES: Play is governed by the USGA Rules of Golf and the PMGA Local Rules.

PACE OF PLAY AND TIME CLOCK: The 14-minute/2:10 rule is in effect.

- Each group must finish each nine holes within 14 minutes of the group ahead, or within 2:10 or less.
- **Time-clock:** One marker must time stamp a scorecard **after** all players have teed off at the beginning of the round, and again **after** all players have completed each nine. At conclusion, there should be three times stamped.
- **Penalty:** one stroke per team for each nine in which a violation occurs.
- A delay due to a lost ball on holes 8, 9, 17, or 18 must be reported to the committee upon completion of the round.
